



## **DAF 2017 Music Promo Competition**

**Submit Your Entry Now!**

**Entry to the competition is FREE.**

The showcase for finalists of the Didsbury Arts Festival (DAF) 2017 Music Promo competition, run in association with Manchester Film School, will take place at Cineworld, East Didsbury on Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2017. This will be a highlight event in the 9-day long arts festival, taking place from Saturday 24 June to Sunday 2 July, 2017. It will be an exciting screening of the shortlisted finalists alongside a music promo workshop with prizes of £100 awarded to the winning film in each category.

### **Categories:**

#### **1 - Directors Aged 16-19 (upon completion of finished film)**

Music Promo Film: Maximum length 5 mins

#### **2 - Directors Aged 19 and above (upon completion of finished film)**

### **Film duration:**

Music Promo Film: Maximum length 5 mins. The timings must include all credits.

### **Shooting formats and Content Submission:**

We will accept films shot in any format, including mobile phones. We will be screening the shortlisted films on a large cinema screen so please do bear that in mind.

Firstly, upload your film to You Tube or Vimeo. You will see that the entry form asks for your URL link as part of your application process. Please also include up to 25 words of text (as it would appear in the programme) to tell us what happens in the footage and the name and age of the director and producer.

We will only accept films shot within the last two years. We would encourage content which has a narrative component and tells a story rather than simply being a live gig, but both will be considered.

Our judging panel will select around 6 films as the shortlist to be screened at the Cineworld event during the DAF festival.

The prize fund, awarded by Manchester Film School, will be £100 per category and only one winning film will be selected in each category.

Details of this year's judging panel and industry session will be announced on the website as part of the online DAF programme launch in April.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ANY PERSON OR ENTITY (“Applicant”)WHO WISHES TO SEND A VIDEO LINK (“Content”) AGREES TO AND IS BOUND BY THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS (“Agreement”)

### 1) Contracting parties

Uploading Content by you evidences your acceptance of this Agreement. All users must be over the age of 16 at the date of entry.

### 2) Submission of Content and other festivals or competitions

If you provide any information to the DAF competition, you agree to provide only true, accurate and complete information to us. You further agree that if you submit any content or material to us, you grant us the right to use your name, likeness and/or biographical materials in all media for the purposes contemplated herein.

There are no restrictions on showing your content on other sites or at other festivals.

### 3) Objectionable Material

You agree not to upload any material that contains imagery or audio content which is:

- a) sexually explicit or suggestive, derogatory of any ethnic, racial, gender, religious or age group, profane or pornographic, contain nudity or any materially dangerous activity;
- b) or promotes illegal activities that may appear unsafe or dangerous or any particular political agenda or message;
- c) be obscene or offensive, endorse any form of hate or hate group;
- d) contain trademarks, logos owned by others or advertise or promote any brand or product of any kind without permission including personal information;
- e) contain copyrighted materials owned by others without permission;
- f) in violation of any law

### 4) Clearance of Rights

If you send in any film, recorded music, text, photographs, graphics or other materials to the competition, you hereby warrant and represent that you personally created, wrote and produced such content or that you have written permission from or are authorised by the owner(s) of those materials for such use.

We will be entitled to, at our discretion, to dismiss any Competition entry which, in our opinion, is objectionable or does not comply with these terms and conditions.

### 5) Competition/festival and Prizes

Participation in the Competition/festival is FREE.

All entries must be verified and accepted by DAF's designated judges and such judges decisions will be final in each case and no correspondence will be entered into. DAF reserves the right to change, suspend or cancel Competitions without specifying reasons and without incurring liability as a result, and to change these terms and conditions and/or the Prizes by notice on the Site (effective from the date of posting). All Prizes are non-transferrable and non-negotiable. DAF reserves the right to substitute any Prize at any time.

#### 6) Notification of competition/festival shortlist and finalists

The competition/festival shortlisted films and finalists will be selected by DAF and its adjudicators from all valid and accepted entries on or after the closing date of the Contest and shall be notified by e-mail. Where further information is requested, the finalists and those who have submitted shortlisted films will have 5 days to respond in full to the request.

If your film is included within the shortlisted programme, you must agree to take part in reasonable post competition publicity surrounding DAF.

#### 7) Winning films

Winners will be announced at the end of the Cineworld Finalists event during the DAF festival. Any winners who are not present will be notified by e-mail and/or mail and telephone.

#### 8) Indemnity

Applicant agrees to indemnify DAF for any loss or damage that may be incurred by DAF, including without limitation legal fees, arising from any breach by Applicant of any warranty herein or User's misuse of any material or information.

#### 9) Laws and Jurisdiction

This agreement shall be governed by and will be constituted in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. Any disputes arising under or in connection with this Agreement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
